Housekeeping Items:

Clover Preschool is closed Monday, October 11th to observe Columbus/Indigenous People Day.

Thank you so much for your cooperation and understanding as we work through cold season and Covid protocols. Our corporate medical director, director of nursing and infection control nurse have been working so incredibly hard to keep everyone safe. Cold/Flu season is definitely tricky with Covid symptoms being so similar. It is the policy of this facility that any child /staff experiencing Covid symptoms stay out until they receive a negative Covid test AND are symptom free for 24 hours with no medication. If vaccinated, staff may work with mild symptoms as long as they wear an n95 mask AND receive a negative Covid test.

If you choose to not test your child for Covid, they will need to quarantine for 14 days.

Covid Symptoms: Fever (over 100) runny nose, cough, congestion, sore throat, shortness of breath, new loss of taste or smell, extreme fatigue, body/muscle aches, headache, vomiting, diarrhea

Please group message all of us on BLOOMZ with information regarding your child. If your child will be out for any reason, please call or message us. We are required by the state to notify all families of possible contagious diseases.
