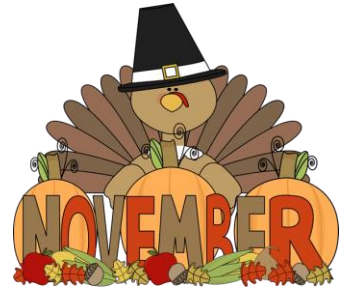


Clover Preschool News
